We are committed to doing all we can to increase the blood supply in the Warwick area and make sure there is always an ample supply of blood for patients in local hospitals.

Our new Warwick Donor Center at St. Anthony Community Hospital is designed to boost the local blood supply by giving residents in the area more opportunities to give blood. Ensuring that there is enough blood, all the time, for anyone who needs it, depends on caring people in the community to roll up their sleeves and donate.

Giving blood is safe, painless, and free. Healthy individuals between the ages of 16 and 75 who weigh at least 110 pounds can donate. When people give blood, they feel good – about contributing to their communities, keeping the blood supply strong and helping to save lives.
